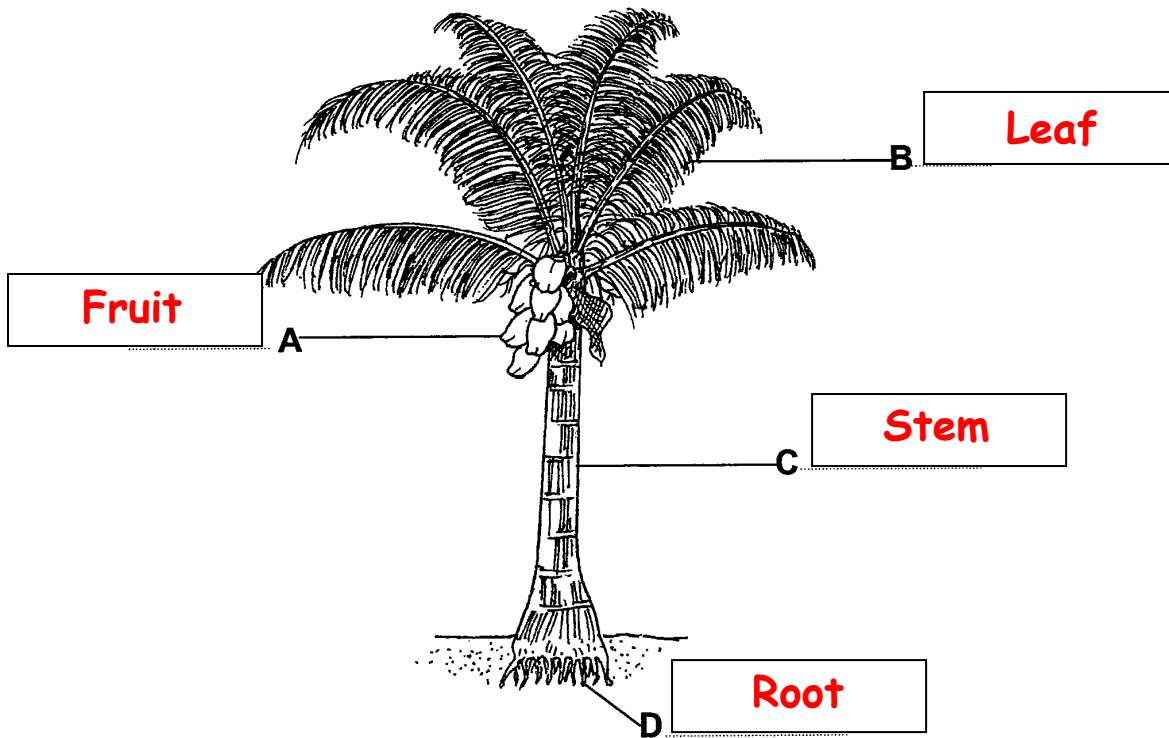


MORE ABOUT PLANTS - (Unit 5)

ANSWERS

The diagram below shows a coconut tree.

1. Label parts A, B, C and D.



2. Fill in each blank with a suitable word chosen from the list below:

roots - firmly - sunlight - trunk - food - branches - absorbs

- (a) The coconut tree has a thick and hard stem known as a **trunk**
- (b) **The main functions** of **part C** are: **the stem**
- (i) It supports the **branches**, leaves, flowers and fruits.
- (ii) It carries water and minerals from the **roots** to the other parts of the plant.
- (iii) It holds the leaves so that they receive a lot of **sunlight**
- (iv) It carries **food** from the leaves to the other parts of the plant.
- (c) **The root** **Part D** holds the plant **firmly** in the soil.
Part D also **absorbs** water and minerals from the soil.
